- Part of the National PTA and its membership of over 4 million.
- An advocacy group before the DoDEA leaders and the Federal Government, working to influence policy makers who deal with education and health issues.
- A network of volunteers who also serve on committees of other organizations that deal with children's issues.
- A source of information on topics affecting children.


The European PTA began in 1958 as the European Congress of American Parents Teachers and Students (ECAPTS) and is a State-Level branch of the [National Parent Teacher Association](#). In 2015, we celebrate our 57th year as a voice for children in the European military community and beyond.

EPTA provides leadership support to our local PTA units; works in cooperation with DoDEA and DoDDS-Europe at all levels; and advocates on behalf of all children. The work of the European PTA is instrumental to enhancing the quality of life for our military children overseas.

## PARENTAL ENGAGEMENT


A primary objective of PTA is to encourage greater involvement of parents with their children in their schools. Studies have shown that a school district would have to spend over \$1000 per child to get the same effect as having a parent, grandparent, or other caring adult involved in that child's education, and it is our goal to ensure that our students are set up for success! PTAs help parents by:

- Providing training and supplemental materials on parenting skills.
- Helping to build family-school partnerships as embodied in the [National Standards for Family-School Partnerships](#).
- Conducting and participating in local and national conferences on child-related issues.
- Continuing to be the largest and most effective association advocating for the education, health, safety and well-being of all children and youth.

## LEGISLATIVE INVOLVEMENT

The National PTA is a strong, proactive advocate for children's issues and has influenced major legislation. The current four key PTA policy areas from the 2014 [National PTA Public Policy Agenda](#) are:

- **EDUCATION**
- **CHILD HEALTH AND NUTRITION**
- **SCHOOL SAFETY**
- **JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION**



# **THE EPTA SUPPORTS LOCAL PTAs THROUGH:**

## **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT**

- Training officers and members through workshops at the annual European PTA Convention and Leadership Training, as well as via many online training resources from National PTA.
- Distributing manuals and pamphlets for use by Local Units.

## **COMMUNICATION**

- Informing local units about events and child-related issues through email bulletins, social media outlets, our website, and our newsletter.
- Providing and/or publishing up-to-date materials on issues related to children, family and school.
- Sponsoring programs such as the Scripps National Spelling Bee and the PTA Reflections Program that recognize student talents.

## **THE EPTA STATE OFFICE**

- Provides help that is readily available by email or telephone.
- Facilitates the flow of information between the local unit, the European PTA, and the National PTA.
